Club involvement

There are four clubs involved in Men's Artistic; 1066 GA, Hawth GC, Wickers GC, Worthing GC.

Regional training

10 July 2016, Hawth GC

This session is aimed at Level 1 (the lowest) level of grades. There will also be a judging clinic incorporated in to the day to help less experienced judges.

Competition results

English Championship, 18-20 March

3 Hawth boys entered the under 12 category. Anton Adawale scored 68.20, Linus Carminger 63.35 and Cody Truman 58.90.

In the Under 14, Louis Gibson scored 61.5.

British Championship (U16, U18, Snr), 8-10 April

Hawth entered 2 boys to the British Championships in Liverpool. Archie Baker scored 64.90. Patrick Smith only competed on three pieces and scored 31.45.

Pipers Vale, 13-15 May

Hawth and Worthing entered gymnasts. This is a great competition covering a wide range of abilities. The challenge event is for younger or less experienced gymnasts, Worthing entered 2 gymnasts and Hawth entered 9 in to this event.

The summary below covers the cup event (for older and more experienced gymnasts):

The Hawth Under 12 team was fourth overall: Anton Adawale 71.40, Cody Trueman 65.85, Linus Carminger 61.40, Reece Besley 65.75.

Henry Clarke (Worthing) competed in Under 14 and scored 57.20.

Harry Harrod (Haw) won U18 category with 73.60.
